STANDING RULES

4. If during the school year, there is a withdrawal from any class, the position will be offered to any parent of a child already in the school. If more than one parent expresses interest in the opening, a lottery will be held to determine who will fill the position. Once it is determined that parents of children already enrolled are not interested in an opening, the first person on the waiting list will be contacted (as long as their child qualifies for the class). If they are not interested in the position, the next person on the waiting list will be called. This will continue until the opening can be filled.

D. The Membership Chairperson shall keep a mailing list.

VI. CALENDAR

- A. The school calendar will follow that of the Hebron School System as closely as possible. All vacation weeks will coincide. Scheduled early dismissal days will not be observed by HCNS. The calendar will be finalized and approved by the June board meeting.

- C. Class sessions canceled due to inclement weather during the school year will be made up at the end of the year only when the following conditions are present. Canceled days in excess of 3 days (C&D) classes will be made up one for one but are limited to 3 days. Canceled days in excess of 2 days (A&B) classes will be made up one for one but are limited to 2 days. There will be one week designated in the POD calendar for canceled days in excess of this will NOT be made up. The number of classes to be made up will be established by May 1st. POD scheduled on inclement or "snow" days will be the POD on the make-up snow day.
